

WHY A PEDIATRIC DENTIST?

A pediatric dentist is a dentist who specializes in the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of dental disease in children and those with special healthcare needs. After completing four years of dental school, a pediatric dental specialist completes an additional two years of rigorous training to understand better how to meet your child's oral health needs. As a specialist, our pediatric dentist is equipped to address your child's dental development, dental decay, prevention, habits, and trauma, while offering more advanced skills in behavior management, such as sedation or surgery.

WHY BABY TEETH MATTER

Baby teeth are essential to the overall health and well-being of your child. A healthy mouth allows your child to eat and grow properly, get the rest they need to concentrate, succeed in school, and interact with other children without embarrassment. Dental decay can lead to pain, infection, and swelling, which can also impact the development of the adult teeth and have potential orthodontic consequences.

VIRGINIA FAMILY DENTISTRY - YOUR CHILD'S 'DENTAL HOME'

Dental decay is caused by a breakdown in the enamel. Bacteria and carbohydrates (sugars) cause the acidic breakdown of the tooth, resulting in a cavity—a preventable process!

To intervene and prevent the early onset of dental decay, Virginia Family Dentistry and the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry encourage the following guidelines:

THE AGE ONE DENTAL VISIT

While it is never too late, we recommend that your child see us at one year of age. At this visit, we can perform a comprehensive assessment of oral diseases and establish risk factors to prevent dental decay, thereby reducing the need for future dental treatment or unnecessary anxiety.

INDIVIDUALIZED CARE

Each child is unique and differs in cognition, development, coping ability, oral health behaviors, medical and dental experiences, and health history. Our doctors will develop a customized plan for your child's prevention and treatment care based on their needs.

ONGOING RELATIONSHIP & GUIDANCE

Children are often more comfortable with routine and recognizable surroundings. Your child's trust in us and our relationship with them is strengthened over time as we deliver the best care through a "comprehensive, accessible, coordinated, and family-centered" approach.

We will provide ongoing opportunities for guidance and education about preventing dental accidents, proper oral hygiene home care, dietary counseling, and age-specific expectations for oral growth and development.

OUR TEAM APPROACH

Our "dental home" provides the focal point for your family to interact with a community of caregivers both inside and outside Virginia Family Dentistry. This can be especially important for the comprehensive dental care of your child who may have a special healthcare need or complex medical condition.

ADVANCED PEDIATRIC CARE

Our "dental home" provides the focal point for your family to interact with a community of caregivers inside and outside Virginia Family Dentistry. This can be especially important for the comprehensive dental care of your child, who may have a particular healthcare need or complex medical condition.

Frenectomy: The "frenum" refers to a piece of soft skin tissue connected to the lips and gums that can interfere with breastfeeding, swallowing, or speech. With a minimally invasive laser procedure, we can remove this connective tissue.

Airway Treatment: Airway disturbances in children have been linked to many conditions, from allergies to Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) to sleep apnea. By correcting the jaws' and teeth' early growth problems using nonsurgical and non-pharmaceutical therapies, we can enhance airway health and reduce the risk of these issues in children.
